Epic Passes

All domestic ski trips in 2025 are Epic! (not IKON)

Purchasing an Epic Pass is the least expensive regardless of choice of trips, but note that not all passes include Telluride. Current prices are as follows:

- ➤ Full Epic Pass: \$982
- ➤ Local Epic Pass: \$731 (not valid for Telluride)
- > 7-Day Epic Pass: \$648
- ➤ 6-Day Epic Pass: \$573
- > 5-Day Epic Pass: \$492
- > 4-Day Epic Pass: \$405
- > 3-Day Epic Pass: \$313 (not valid for Telluride)
- 2-Day Epic Pass: \$214 (not valid for Telluride)
- ➤ 1-Day Epic Pass: \$110 (not valid for Telluride)

Please purchase these thru Ski.com as for every 25 passes bought, the club gets a reimbursement for one.

General Information

- All pricing is estimated on the high side \(\begin{aligned} \\ \\ \ \end{aligned} \).
- Lodging is NOT reserved yet!
 - Please make your reservations as early as possible!!!
 - Trips need 20 minimum to be valid, 30 maximum.
 - All deposits are refundable until contract signed or if cancelled.
 - If we don't get at least 20, we'll have to cancel trip.
 - Lodging isn't guaranteed until we sign contract.
- Reserving bedding configurations for condo-style is a royal PIA and carries a risk in "most" cases.
 - Second (of 2/2) and third (of 3/3) bedrooms can be a queen bed, pair of single beds, or a bunk bed.
 - Resorts attempt to match our requests but will NOT guarantee our request.
- If we get a high enough couples to singles ratio, we reserve the right to switch lodging (and save money) to condo-style.
- 2 Singles will always be matched up to share a room (double occupancy) unless someone is willing to pay a single room upcharge.
- Airfare and ground transportation costs are not yet available!



Basic Lodging Info

- Telluride Mountain Lodge
 - All condos are fixed bedding
 - 2/2 is king/queen downstairs and pair of singles in loft
 - 3/3 is king/queen in downstairs bedrooms and queen in loft

- Vail Tivoli
 - Hotel room style (2 per room)
 - We should be able to request king or 2 singles accordingly.
- Park City Silverado
 - Hotel room style (2 per room)
 - We should be able to request king or 2 singles accordingly.
