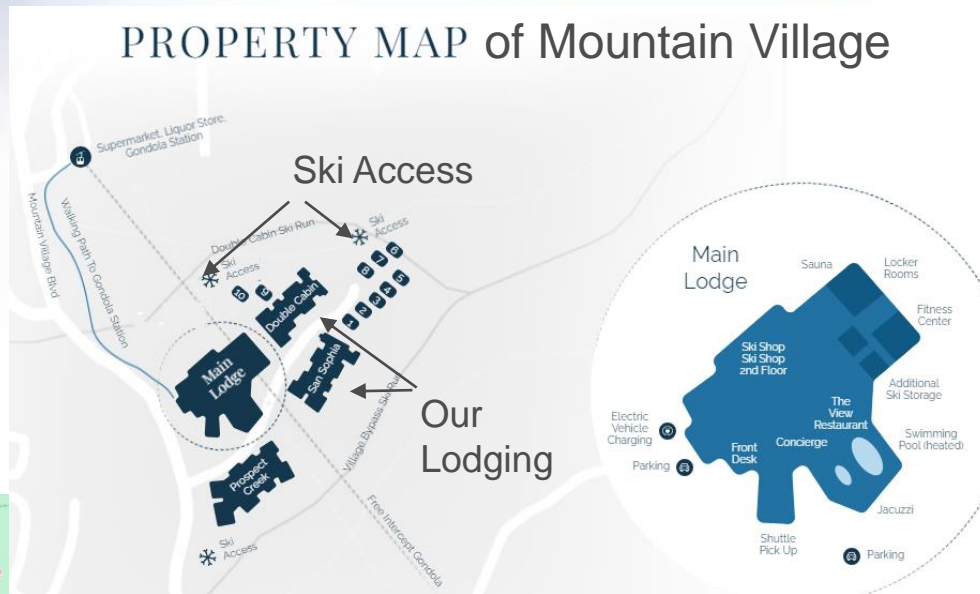

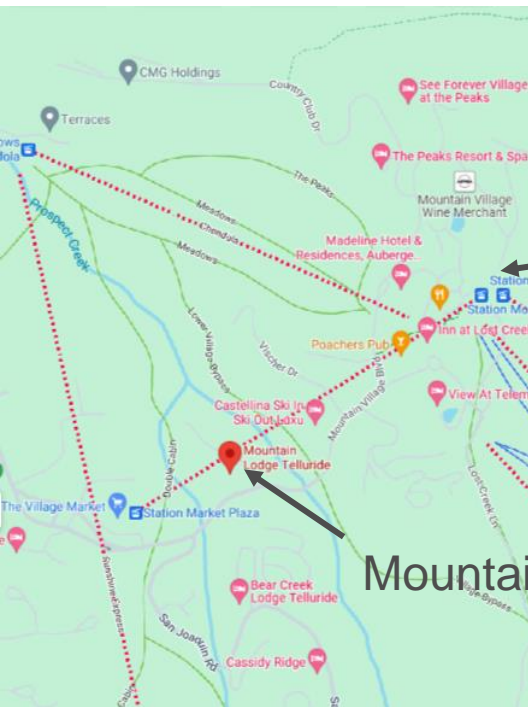

PROPERTY MAP of Mountain Village

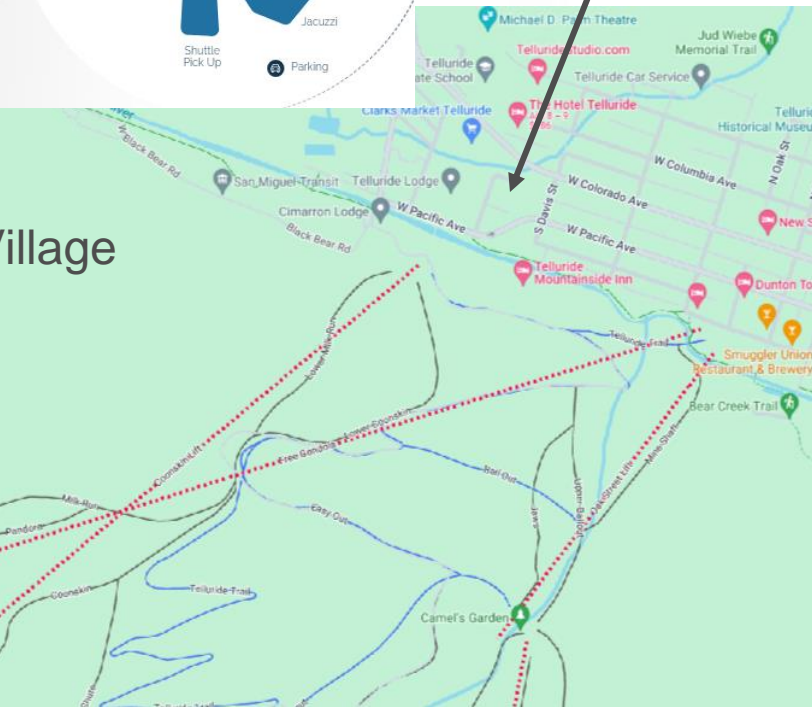

Difference between Telluride and Mountain Village

The Town of Telluride is rich in history. What started as just another “Wild West” mining camp in the mid 1800s became a renowned ski town a century later. Mountain Village was established soon after this in the 1990s as a resort town resting above historic Telluride. The history of each location is still significant to this day.

Downtown Telluride oozes character, with quaint historic buildings lining the streets and several local history museums. There is a wide variety of activities to enjoy right in Telluride, from shopping, restaurants, and festivals to numerous easily accessible hiking trails to the nightlife scene in town.

Mountain Village was established purposefully as a luxury ski resort town and while it is by no means pretentious, the town does offer more of an upscale experience to those who lodge there. Telluride Ski Resort is located in Mountain Village and allows visitors access to all kinds of terrain as well as hosting ski lessons for all levels.

Many of the accommodations allow you to ski in/ski out. And if you’re looking for fine dining apres-ski, Mountain Village is the place to be.

Easy access between the two is provided by the free gondola.



Amenities

- The Main Lodge is for amenities only - no lodging.
 - The View restaurant with an open fireplace area behind it which would be great for a pizza party?
 - 2 heated hot tubs (4-7 people) and a heated pool
 - Fitness Center and Steam/Sauna Room (free)
- Each lodging building has it's own set of inside ski storage lockers. The Main Lodge also has outdoor storage racks which are pulled in nightly.
- Listed as ski-in/ski-out. But the concierge says that there is a short walk from either building to the ski access.
- Available On-Call shuttle service from the Main Lodge.
- About a 10 minute walk to Mountain Village Center or use the shuttle (restaurants and shopping).
- Less than a 5 minute walk to the full grocery store (Village Market), liquor store and Gondola station (to Telluride), or use the shuttle.
- Non-ski activities: Winter Horseback Riding, Snowmobiling, Sleigh Rides, Ice Skating, Fat Tire Biking, Dog Sled Tours and more...



Mountain Village Rooms

- Final decision will be based on signups and the number of singles and couples.
- All Rooms will be 2 bedroom / 2 bath suites (and possibly 3 bedroom / 3 bath suites). Configuration is upon request (so we need to decide quickly).
- Full kitchens

Telluride Costs
